To: Elementary Teachers, Social Studies Teachers, and Administrators From: Cheryl J. Lebo, Associate Supt. for Standards and Assessment Re: New Social Studies Achievement Certificate

Dear Educator:

In our continuing effort to raise awareness of the importance of developing a well-rounded social studies background for all students, the Arizona Department of Education has initiated a Social Studies Achievement Certificate.

This certificate is very similar to the Reading and Science Achievement Certificates inasmuch as it gives students extra incentive to learn outside the classroom and be recognized for demonstrating added knowledge of a core subject.

The ADE has compiled a list of *suggested* locations throughout the state of Arizona that represent an area of historic and/or geographic interest and importance. This is not meant to be the definitive list of such areas, but is designed to help teachers, students and parents in their efforts to visit locations that have historic and geographic merit.

For example, a visit to Yuma Quartermaster Depot State Historic Park would give a student appreciation for history, geography, and economics. A trip to Walnut Canyon National Monument would offer opportunities to explore history and geography, and time spent in the many history museums statewide holds obvious potential.

In order to receive a certificate, the student should demonstrate some added knowledge of social studies to the satisfaction of his or her teacher. The ADE does not wish to be prescriptive in this effort. If the educator believes the student has earned recognition, then that student is eligible for the certificate. The goal is to encourage independent study of social studies.

Below is a list of suggested Arizona social studies attractions.
