In Home Sales of Hearing Aids (effective September 1, 2006)

Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 331-640-0030(10) Statement to Prospective Purchaser

In Home Sales. Sales of hearing aids made at the purchaser's residence and not at the licensee's place of business, require disclosure of federal guidelines related to "in home sales" and the purchaser's right to cancel the transaction and receive a full refund of monies paid to the licensee. The following federal disclosure statement must be completed and affixed to the *Statement to Prospective Purchaser* when a licensee sells a hearing aid(s) at the purchaser's home:

NOTICE OF CANCELLATION

You may cancel this transaction, without any penalty or obligations, within three business days from the above date. If you cancel, any property traded in any payments made by you under the contract of sale, and any negotiable instrument executed by you will be returned within 10 business days following receipt by the seller of your cancellation notice, and any security interest arising out of the transaction will be canceled.

If you cancel, you must make available to the seller at your residence, in substantially as good condition as when received, any goods delivered to you under this contract or sale; or you may if you wish, comply with the instructions of the seller regarding the return shipment of the goods at the seller's expense and risk.

If you do make the goods available to the seller and the seller does not pick them up within 20 days of the date of your notice of cancellation, you may retain or dispose of the goods without any further obligation. If you fail to make the goods available to the seller, or if you agree to return the goods to the seller and fail to do so, then you remain liable for performance of all obligations under the contract.
