REVENUE TO CLOSE EVERGREEN PARK OFFICE OCTOBER 28

Online Services and Revenue at Thompson Center Available

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Revenue will close its office at 9730 S. Western Ave. in Evergreen Park on Thursday, October 28. The department makes this move to comply with reductions in Revenue's FY 2005 budget cuts.

Taxpayers who need assistance can visit the Department of Revenue's website at www.ILtax.com or call the department at (800) 732-8866. The closest office is in the James R. Thompson Center at 100 W. Randolph in Chicago.

Personnel in the Evergreen Park office will be assigned to other Department of Revenue facilities.

The Department of Revenue is improving efficiency and accuracy in its core mission of collecting taxes and assuring compliance with tax laws through enhanced electronic service, filing and payment options. Revenue's online capability is under constant refinement and individuals are able to do much of the business they transacted in local offices from their own computers.

Also closed on October 28 will be the Department of Revenue office in Rock Island.
