Family Activity - Hats Off to Museum Careers!

Learning Objectives

After this activity, the learner will be able to choose which museum worker, does what job to create an exhibition.

Advance Organizer

It takes a team of museum workers to create an exhibition. Each worker has a different job.

The **collections manager** makes sure that objects are stored correctly and are well taken care of, while a **curator** studies the objects and writes a story about them. A **conservator** might use special tools and methods if an object needs repair. The **exhibition designer** decides the best way to display the objects. And an **educator** creates activities for visitors to better understand the exhibition.
