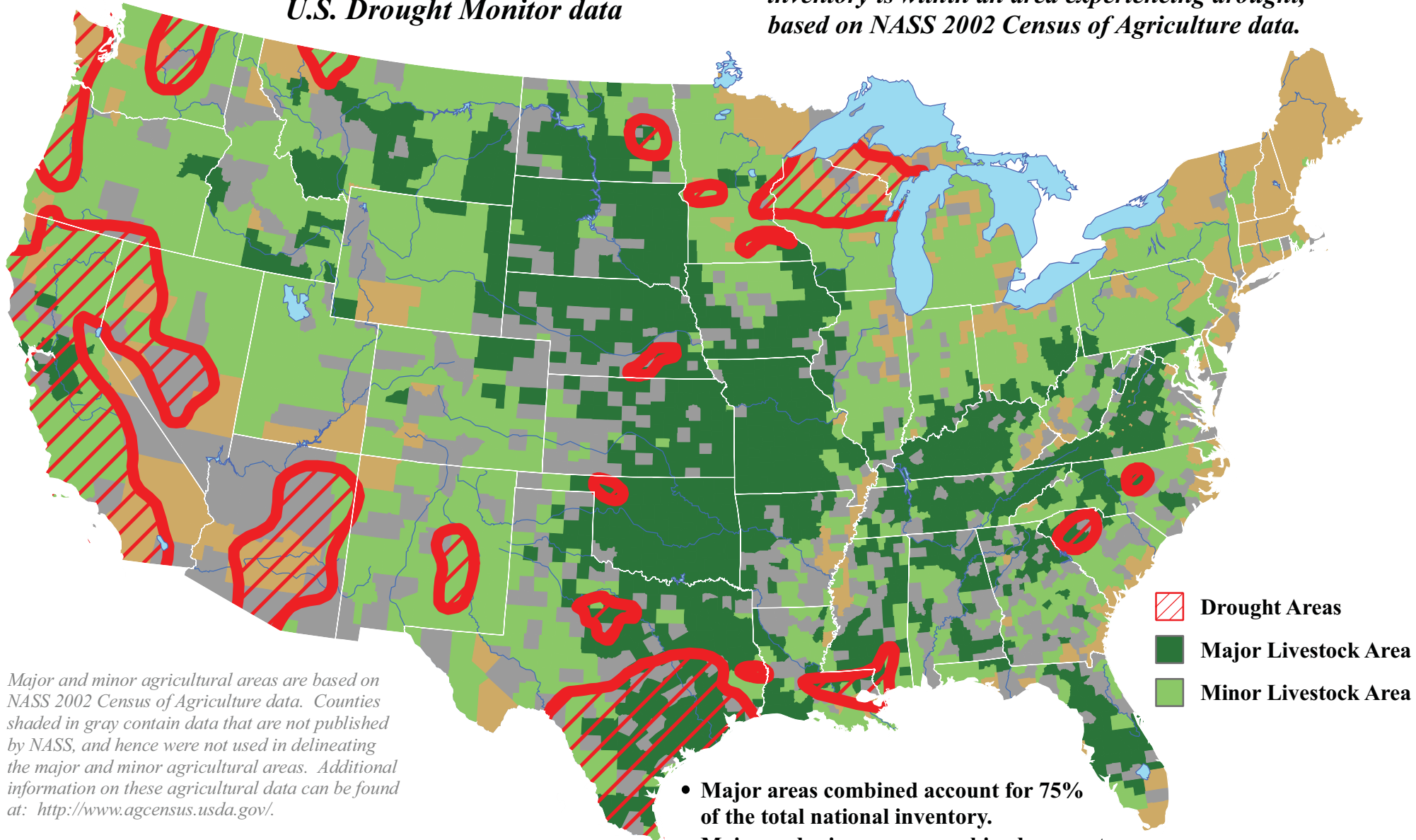


U.S. Beef Cow Areas Experiencing Drought

Reflects August 25, 2009
U.S. Drought Monitor data

Approximately 12% of the domestic beef cow inventory is within an area experiencing drought, based on NASS 2002 Census of Agriculture data.



Major and minor agricultural areas are based on NASS 2002 Census of Agriculture data. Counties shaded in gray contain data that are not published by NASS, and hence were not used in delineating the major and minor agricultural areas.
