Form M-2 is no longer required by DPSST because statutory authority was adopted to provide for standard designation of beneficiaries.

House Bill 2238 became effective January 1, 2004. The bill provides, in part, the following designations for benefits to the survivor of a public safety officer who suffered a qualifying death:

- “(a) 100 percent to the surviving spouse.
- (b) If there is no surviving spouse, 100 percent to the surviving child.
- (c) If there is no surviving spouse or child, 100 percent to a person who qualifies as a dependent of the public safety officer for state income tax purposes.
- (d) If there is no surviving spouse or child or dependent, 100 percent to the parent of the public safety officer.”
