Cannon Beach expands its e-permitting services

Plumbing contractors can now pull permits 24/7

(Cannon Beach) — Contractors in Cannon Beach can now buy plumbing permits — in addition to mechanical permits — without having to leave home or the office.

Cannon Beach has expanded its online permitting service to include plumbing permits. A state-sponsored Web site, www.BuildingPermits.Oregon.gov, allows contractors to apply and pay for multiple permits from multiple building departments any hour of the day, any day of the week. The Cannon Beach Building Department is the first north coast building department to offer services online through the site, which is hosted by the state Department of Consumer and Business Services' Building Codes Division. Cannon Beach began offering mechanical permits through www.BuildingPermits.Oregon.gov in early February.

Other participating building departments include Beaverton, Hillsboro, Milwaukie, Portland, Oregon City, Medford, Eugene, Lake Oswego, and Springfield and Lane, Washington, and Clackamas counties.
