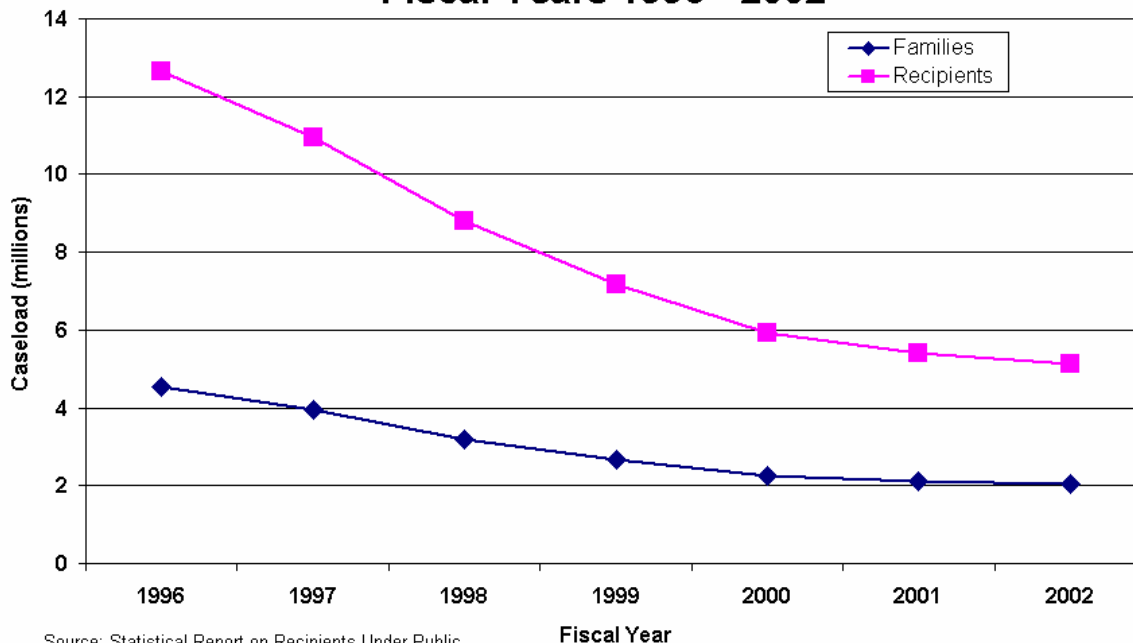

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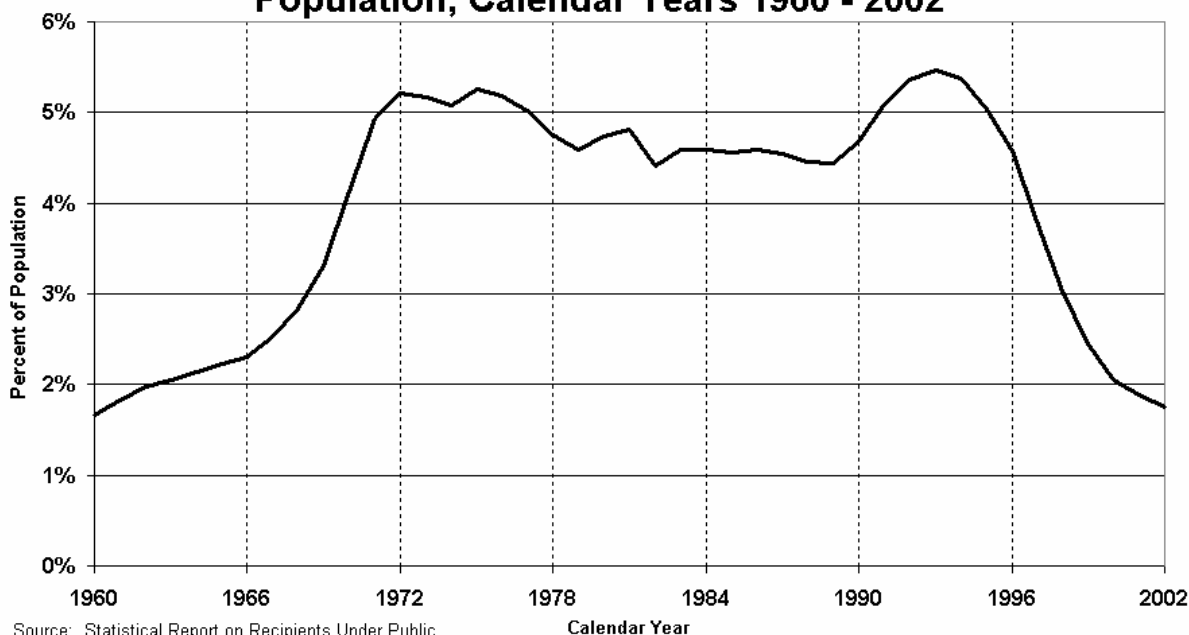
Chart 1:1*

Population, Calendar Years 1960 - 2002

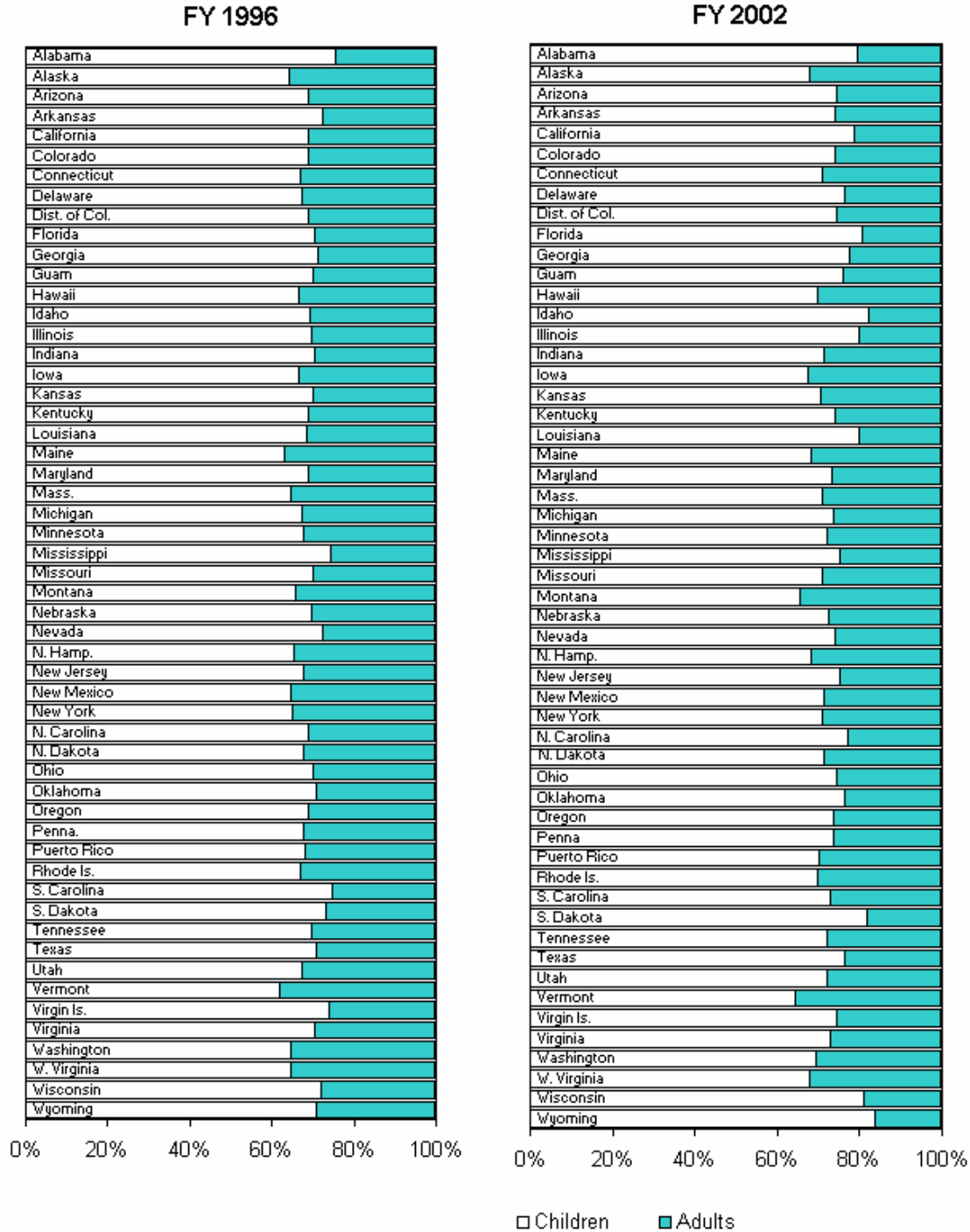

Since enactment of TANF, 7.2 million people have left the rolls.

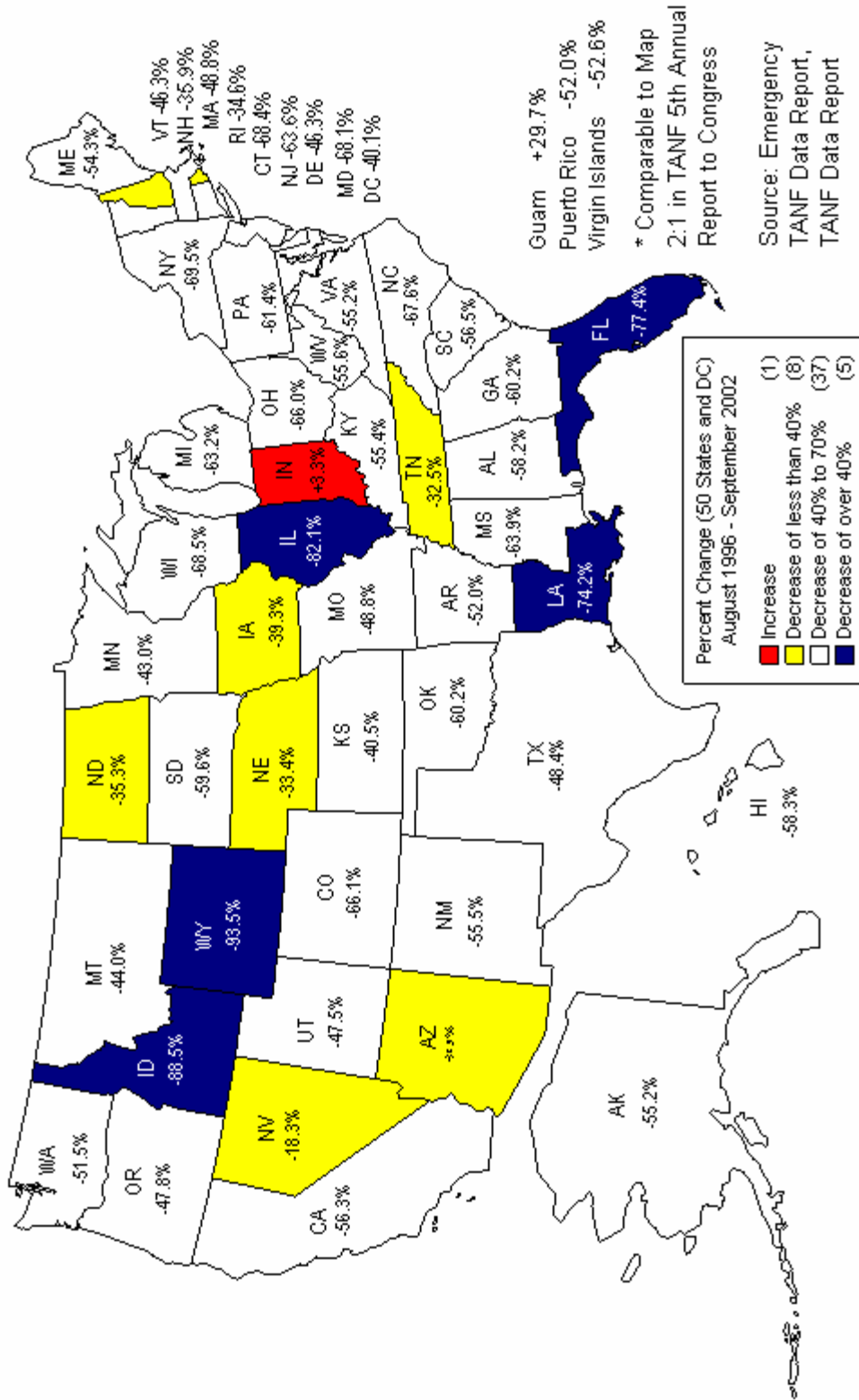
