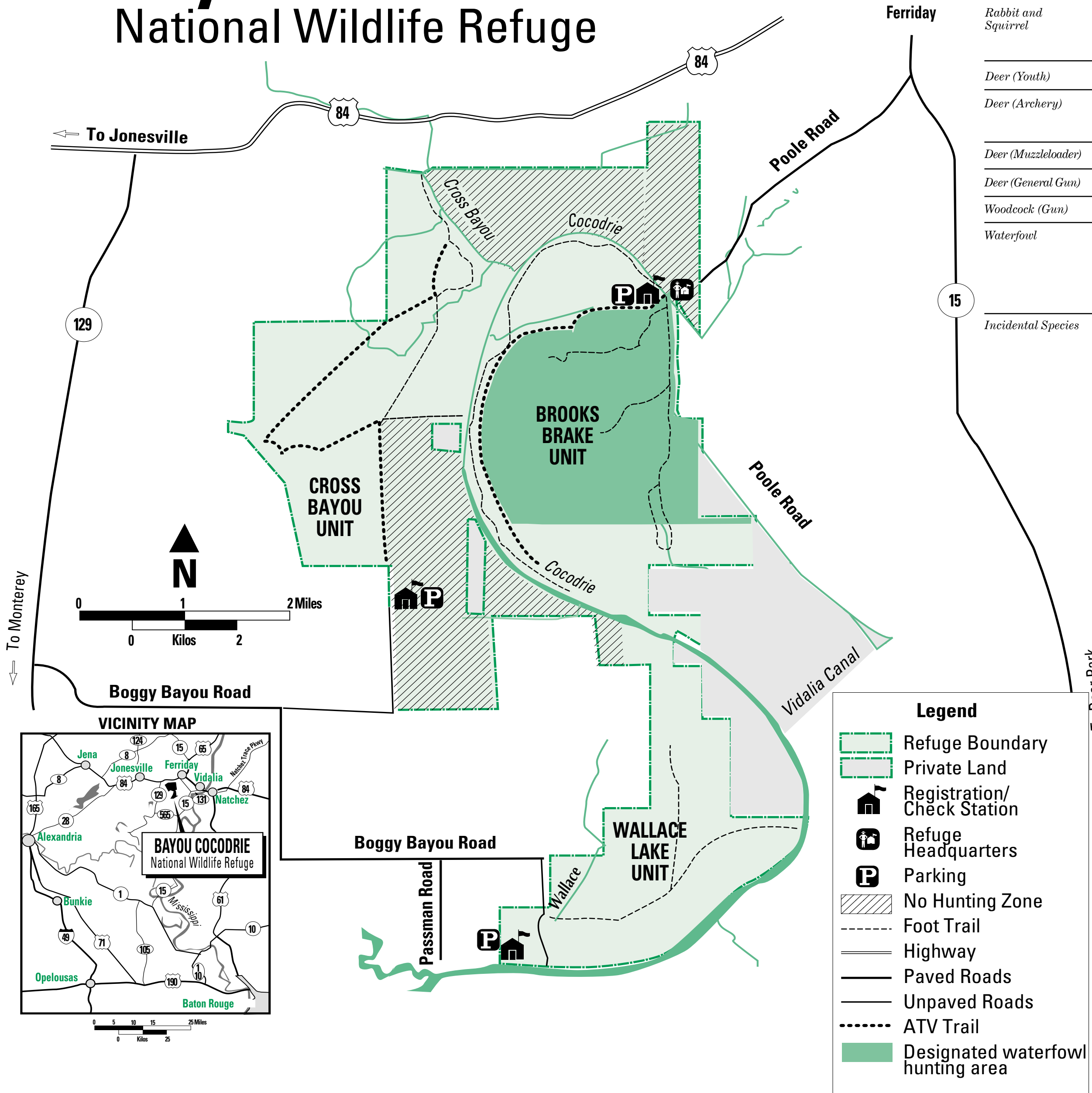


Bayou Cocodrie National Wildlife Refuge

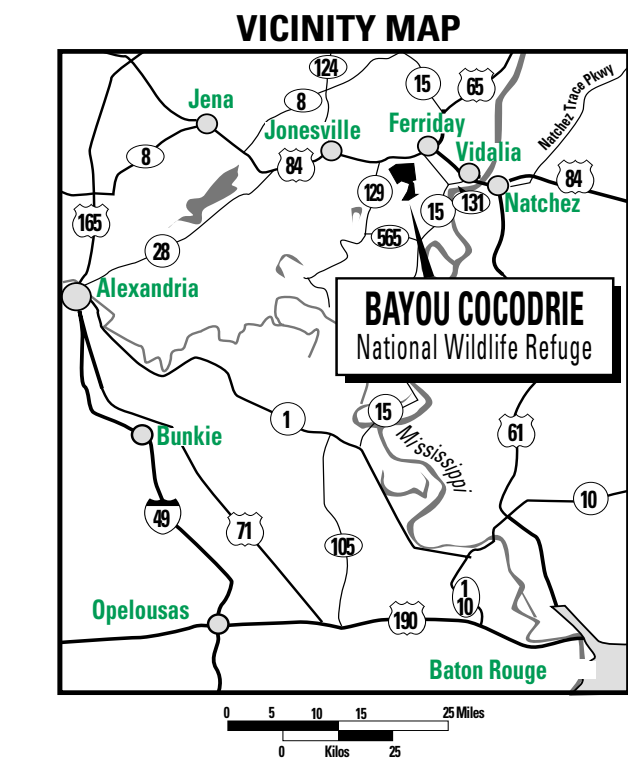


Refuge Hunts
Only the species listed below may be taken. State bag limits apply. Exception: 1 deer per day on the refuge, not to exceed 6 deer per year.

<i>Rabbit and Squirrel</i>	Oct.6-Nov. 2, 2001 (without dogs) Nov. 5-Nov.9, 2001 (without dogs) Jan. 21-Feb.10, 2002 (with or without dogs)
<i>Deer (Youth)</i>	Nov. 3-Nov.4, 2001 (either sex)
<i>Deer (Archery)</i>	Nov. 5-Nov. 9, 2001 (either sex) Nov. 12-Dec. 7, 2001 (either sex) Dec. 10-Jan. 20, 2002 (either sex)
<i>Deer (Muzzleloader)</i>	Nov. 10-Nov. 11, 2001 (either sex)
<i>Deer (General Gun)</i>	Dec. 8-9, 2001 (either sex)
<i>Woodcock (Gun)</i>	Jan. 21-Jan .31, 2002
<i>Waterfowl</i>	State season (open until noon only on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, closed December 8-9 for deer gun hunt). Open east of Brooks Brake ATV trail north of old growth area only (see map).

Incidental Species
Coyote, Beaver, Feral hog, Raccoon
Bag limit exception: 1 raccoon per day.

Incidental species may be taken during any refuge hunt by any hunter having the required permits and licenses.



Signs and Boundaries
Honor Refuge Boundaries: Please respect the rights of our refuge neighbors. Become familiar with refuge boundaries and avoid trespassing on private land.

Signs are useful tools in regulating the use of a public area. The wording of the sign applies to the area behind the sign. Please respect the following signs.

This sign delineates the refuge boundary. Always know the regulations before entering.



All hunting and possession of any weapon is prohibited beyond this sign.



This area is closed to all public entry. Exceptions stated on sign.
