This form allows contractors to report to the Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of the Inspector General (OIG) any information the contractor has concerning fraud, waste, or abuse in a DOJ contract or subcontract. Contractors should use this form to comply with the December 12, 2008, FAR Amendment, 73 Fed. Reg. 67064, which requires contractors to report credible evidence of violations of the civil False Claims Act or certain violations of criminal law that have occurred in connection with a government contract.
