The program format emphasizes student-centered, hands-on learning using entertaining and thought-provoking activities.

Parents: We request your cooperation in registering students only when they meet the grade requirements.

You must register to attend any Adventure. When registering list one name and one adventure per line. You may pay by check, charge or cash. If paying by check, pay with separate checks: one check/adventure/student. Complete the registration form, mail or fax it with your payment. The registration deadline for all Science Adventures is one week prior to the scheduled date, but registrations will continue to be accepted until the Adventure date if there is room. Fees will be returned if we cancel a class. You will not be charged if you cancel your registration one week prior to the class.
