Pursuant to Chapter III of the Rules of the Judicial Council Governing

Complaints of Judicial Misconduct or Disability under 28 U.S.C. § 352(c),

complainant has filed a petition for review of the order of the Chief Judge entered

on August 18, 2008, dismissing the complaint against a magistrate judge of this

circuit.

We have carefully reviewed the record and the authorities cited by the Chief Judge in his order of dismissal. We conclude there is no basis for overturning the order of dismissal. The record shows that while petitioner claims he mailed a petition to proceed in forma pauperis, none was filed/submitted.

For the reasons stated by the Chief Judge and based upon the controlling authority cited in support thereof, we affirm.
