ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

A misconduct complaint has been filed against a district judge.

Complainant, a pro se prisoner, was convicted and sentenced in district court.

Complainant alleges that it was improper for his sentence to include a term of supervised release and that his sentence should have been corrected. These charges relate directly to the merits of the decisions in the underlying case and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B). A misconduct complaint is not a proper vehicle for challenging the merits of a judge's rulings. See In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982).
