Pursuant to Title XV, Subtitle A, section 1511 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L. 111.5 (February 15, 2009)) (ARRA), I, John Diamond, Mayor of the City of Glens Falls (lead agency for Greater Glens Falls Transit), hereby certify that the infrastructure investments funded by ARRA and attached hereto, appropriated under ARRA as Transit Capital Assistance through the Federal Transit Administration, have received the full review and vetting required by law and that I accept responsibility that such investments are appropriate uses of taxpayer dollars.
