

Fort Peck/Dry Prairie Rural Water

Project Description

The Fort Peck/Dry Prairie Rural Water System will provide drinking water to 27,434 people in eastern Montana. Recovery Act funding will be used to complete construction of the water treatment plant, and accelerate: rights-of-way acquisition, engineering design, and construction of project pipeline segments.

- Will allow for continual project construction which will provide future drinking water to area residents currently relying on poor quality water supplies.
