All Weather Road Surfacing - #18

Need: The Lakeview District has many high-use roads that are being damaged during wet weather due to lack of surfacing and base for the roads. These roads are consistantly rutted and mudded, leaving them useless to low clearance vehicles without excessive annual maintenance.

Recovery Act Funding: Funding for this project will be used for dig outs, constructing rock base and adding crushed rock surfacing to high-use roads in the district. Roads have been indentified in the Klamath Falls Vicinity, in the Gerber Block, at the Sand Dunes Recreation site near Christmas Vally and in the Warner Valley east of Lakeview.



Benefits: This project will allow year round use of roads in the District indentified as high maintenance and high use. This will signicantly reduce future maintenance of these roads that have been tyipcally rutted during springtime use.
