

Design for LEED Replacement Fire Cache Facilities with Office Space – #33

Need: This project will design new facilities to replace two warehouses and retrofit the existing buildings to an LEED certified silver rating. Both existing buildings have structural issues and are within the flood plain. The existing buildings are used by the BLM and Forest Service for a fire cache warehouse and offices for fire and law enforcement staff.

Recovery Act Funding: Phase I of this project will likely use an existing architectural and engineering contract.

Benefits: The Rivers and Prarie Fire Division with agreements with several area fire departments supports wildfire suppression to the central Oregon urban interface. The area includes about 3 million acres of federal and state managed lands. The area is home to approximately



250,000 people including 12 designation resorts, and 104 recreation sites along 3 wild and scenic rivers.
