
Roseburg Office Heating, Ventilating, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) System Replacement – #36

Need: The existing HVAC system for the BLM owned Roseburg District Office is over 35 years old. The system is inefficient, requires a high level of maintenance and repair and needs to be replaced.

The project would replace the existing system with a modern, energy-efficiently designed HVAC system.

Recovery Act Funding: Work will begin immediately after the contracts have been awarded and will continue for the next 12 to 18 months creating 3 to 4 jobs.

The project will use architectural and engineering, engineers, and construction contractors for system evaluation, engineering design, materials and labor, heavy equipment and operators for construction and installation, and inspectors.



Benefits: The upgraded HVAC system will be more energy-efficient and cost effectiveness than the existing system.
