Roseburg Recreation Site Comfort Station Replacement – #37

Need: Five existing recreation site toilets are worn and not as cost effective or environmentally safe as concrete vault toilets.

The project would replace the toilets (comfort stations) at 5 high-use recreation sites outside of Roseburg in Douglas County. The sites include: Millpond Campground, Swiftwater Day-use Area, Swiftwater Trailhead, Wolf Creek Falls Trailhead, and Susan Creek Day-use Area).

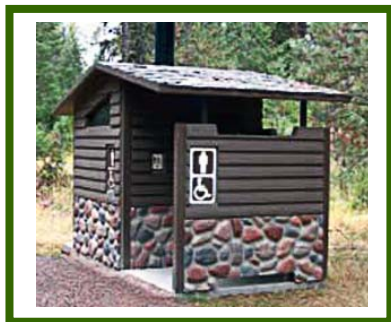
Recovery Act Funding: Work will begin immediately and will continue for the next 12 to 18 months creating 2 to 3 jobs. Local sub-contractors will be needed to dig septic holes, crane-lift vault unit into place, and landscape the sites.
