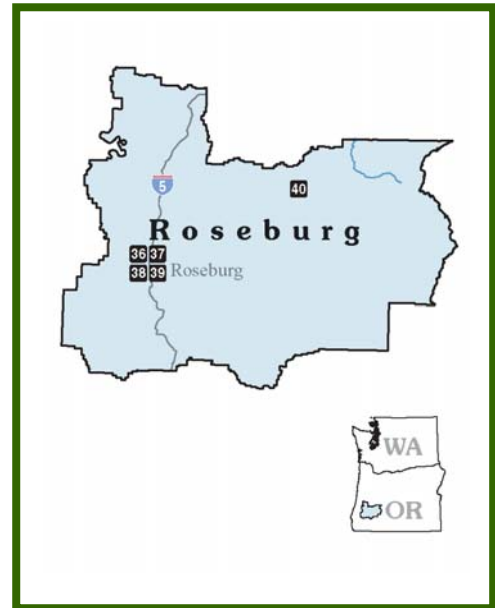
Roseburg Crushed Rock Stockpiles – #40

Need: Maintaining 1,000 miles of roads often requires resurfacing with crushed rock and having a supply stockpiled is needed for cost effective and efficient repair.

Roads throughout the BLM Roseburg District are used to access to public lands for recreation, fire control, resource management and both public and private timber.

Recovery Act Funding: Work will be completed through various contracts and authorization processes. About 20 to 30 jobs will be created over 12 to 18 months.

Work will be completed in cooperation with adjoining landowners, existing right of way holders, the Douglas Forest Protective Association, and Douglas County staff.



Benefits: Resurfacing high priority roads will provide for all weather use of the road system for a variety of uses while protecting against sediment delivery to area streams and rivers from degraded roads.
