Wild and Scenic River Weed Treatments – #60

Need: This project will inventory and treat noxious weeds sites within the Wild and Scenic River (WSR) corridors of the John Day, Deschutes and Crooked Rivers. The project also includes several Wild and Scenic Areas (WSA) as identified below.

Areas of focus include:

- Lower John Day WSR (149 miles), including portions of Spring Basin Wilderness, Lower John Day WSA, North Pole Ridge WSA and Thirtymile WSA
- South Fork John Day WSR (47 miles)
- North Fork John Day River (37 Miles Recommended as suitable for WSR)
- Lower Deschutes WSR (100 miles)
- Middle Deschutes WSR (20 miles), including portions of the Steelhead Falls WSA
- Middle and Lower Crooked WSRs (18 miles)
- North Fork Crooked WSR (19 miles), including North Fork WSA
- South Fork Crooked River (15 miles not designated), including South Fork and Sand Hollow WSAs



Recovery Act Funding: To complete the project, agreements will be established with seven counties (Grant, Crook, Gilliam, Deschutes, Wasco, Sherman, and Jefferson) and the North Fork John Day Watershed Counsel. The project will be accomplished over a two to four year period.

Benefits: This comprehensive and integrated approach to weed management with our partners will help meet the goal of protecting and enhancing the outstanding and remarkable values of the wild and scenic rivers.
