	The Department of Defense (DoD) obligated \$92.6M during the week ending Jun 12, 2009, bringing the cumulative obligation of Recovery Act funds to \$732.1M. The \$732.1M in obligations include \$666.5M for the Facilities Sustainment, Restoration and Modernization (FSRM) program, \$38.5M for the Military Construction Program, \$23.9M for the Near Term Energy-Efficient Technologies Program and \$3.2M for the Homeowner Assistance Program (HAP). These obligations represent 9.9% of all DoD Recovery Act Funds received and reflect over 950 contracts to non-Federal vendors. Of the contracts awarded, over 84% were awarded to small businesses (69% of contract dollars).	Continue to award contracts and monitor execution with a target of \$1.9 billion in military construction and facility repair work underway by August 31.						
2	The Army obligated \$30.6M for multiple FSRM projects this week for a cumulative obligation total for all programs of \$182.3M. These FSRM projects included \$13.5M to repair/replace the Tacoma, WA pier; \$4.7M to replace water mains at Ft. Drum, NY; and multiple smaller projects at bases including Ft. Wainwright AK: Ft. Leavenworth KS; and West Point Military Reservation, NY	On June 17, DoD will meet with representatives of the Recovery Implementation Office to discuss DoD implementation of Recovery Act programs.						
3		The Interim Final Rule for HAP is expected to be submitted to OMB soon.						
4	The Air Force obligated \$44.4M this week for a cumulative obligation total of \$412.3M. Contracts awarded this week include multiple FSRM projects at Eglin Air Force Base (AFB), FL for \$12.1M; Hill AFB, UT for \$5.6M; Columbus AFB, MS for \$5.0M; Tinker AFB, OK for \$2.8M; and Edwards AFB. CA for \$1.2M.							
5	On June 8, DoD participated in the "Roadmap to Recovery" cabinet meeting to discuss the effects of the Recovery Act, as well as plans to accelerate execution over the next 100 days. DoD plans to have over 2.300 projects underway by August 31.							
	On June 12, the draft Interim Final Rule documents for the Homeowners Assistance Program (HAP) were sent to Washington Headquarters Service (WHS) and the DoD General Counsel for final internal DoD review.							
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
