



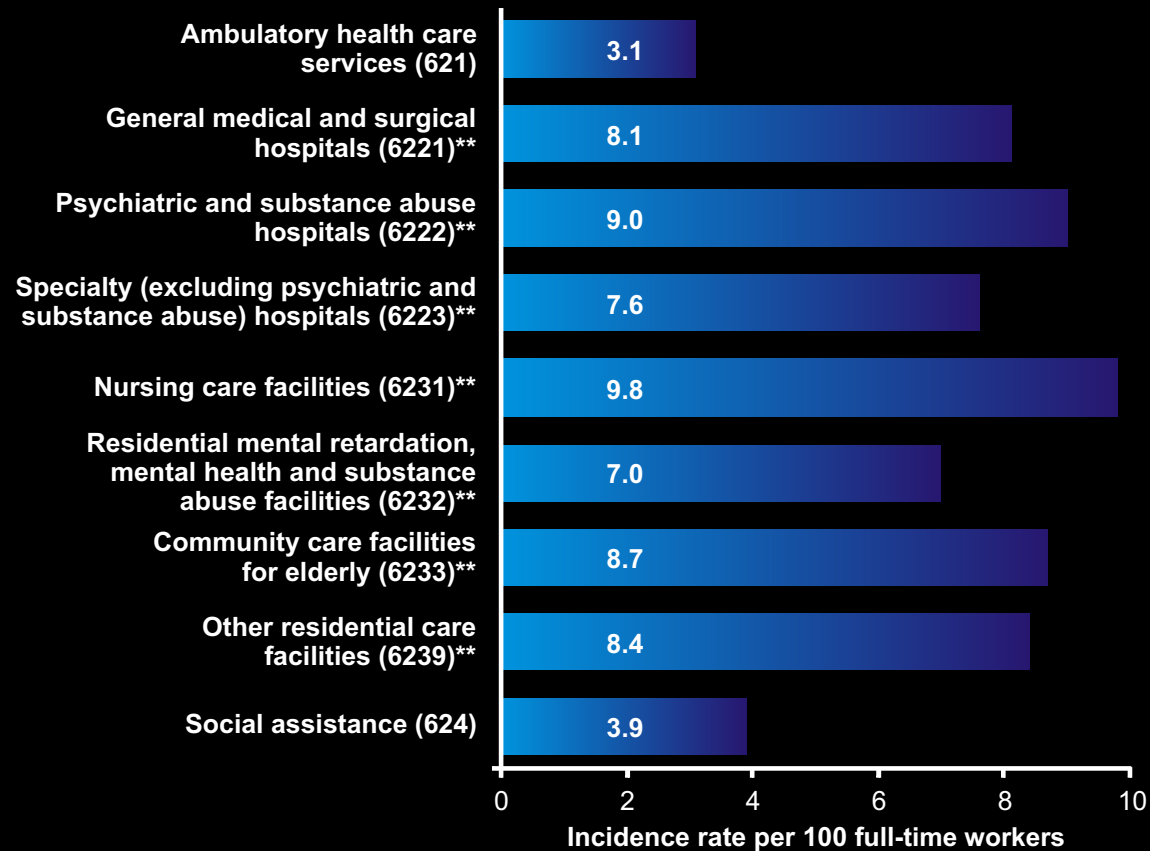
In 2006, nursing care facilities had the highest rate of cases (9.8 per 100 full-time workers) among health care and social assistance industries, with 20,000 cases or more.

Hospitals (NAICS 622) accounted for more than 4 in 10 injury and illness cases in this sector, with general medical and surgical hospitals (NAICS 6221) accounting for most of these.

Estimates within this sector were published at more detailed levels than have been available in the past, allowing for more detailed comparisons among these industries in 2006.
