

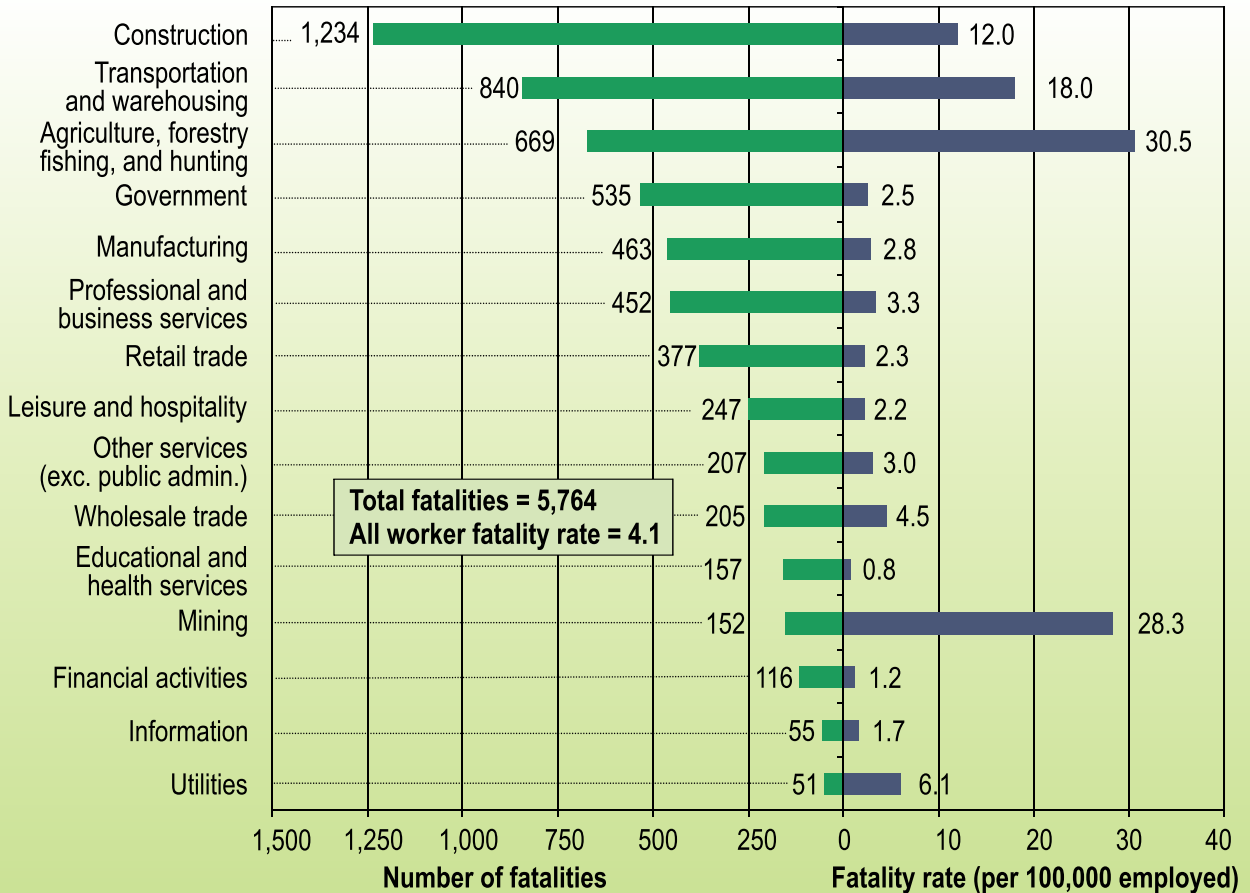

The greatest number of fatal work injuries occurred in the private construction sector, followed by transportation and warehousing.

The highest fatality rates were in agriculture, forestry, fishing, and hunting and in mining. Both of these industry sectors had fatality rates about 7 times greater than the rate of 4.1 per 100,000 for all workers.
