1. WOULD YOU BE KIND ENOUGH TO GET FOLLOWING MSG TO AMBASSADOR HELMS FROM []

"MR. ANGIE KANELLOPOULOS CONTACTED ME TODAY (21 JULY). HE EXPRESSED GREAT REGRET THAT, BECAUSE OF PRESENT EMERGENCIES HERE, A DISLOCATION APPEARS VERY PROBABLY IN YOUR VACATION PLANS.

"SITUATION IS THAT FOR THE PRESENT CGC WILL NOT PERMIT "SOUTH WIND" (OR ANY OTHER YACHT) TO LEAVE ITS BERTH. ADDITIONALLY, THREE OF SIX-MAN CREW HAVE BEEN MOBILIZED AND HE DUBIOUS THAT THEY WILL RETURN BY 25 JULY EVEN IF SITUATION EASES RAPIDLY.

"DESPITE FOREGOING HE WISHERS ASSURE YOU THAT IF "SOUTH WIND" PERMITTED TO LEAVE PORT BY 25 JULY AND YOU DON'T OBJECT TO THREE-MAN CREW (IN VIEW HIS AGE, AM CERTAIN THIS INCLUDES COOK) THE BOAT WILL BE READY TO GO.

"FINALLY, WHILE ANGIE HAS YOUR BROTHER'S ADDRESS IN SUISSE, IS DIFFICULT FOR HIM TO GET WIRE OUT OF GREECE. HE TRUSTS YOU WILL GET WORD TO YOUR BROTHER.

"ANGIE IS CLOSE, PERSONAL FRIEND OF MINE AND IF YOU WISH TO GET ANY WORD BACK TO HIM VIA THIS CHANNEL, I SHALL BE MOST HAPPY TO TAKE CARE OF IT. WARM REGARDS."
