THE SECRETARY HAS ASKED TO BRING YOU THE SECRETARY WITH REFERENCE TO YOUR UP TO DATE ON TRANSAN CO-PRODUCTION IN THE EVENT THE SHAH SHOULD RATS

THE QUESTION ON DECEMBER 22. UNFORTUNATELY, THE UNDER SECRETARIES SIDY OF WHICH YOU ARE AWARE HAS NOT YET BEEN COMPLETED AND FORGERIES REASON YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED BY HE STUDY ON TOW CO-PRODUCTION FORG PASS-ING TO THE SHAH. OBVIOUSLY, THERE ARE SENSITIVITIES IN THIS COUNTRY. INCL UD ING. CONGRESS AND THE TRADE UNIONS. TO DEVELOPMENTS WHICH APPEAR TO HAVE AN IMPACT ON US EMPLOYMENT, BALANCE OF PAYMENTS AND COMPETI-Tion with american products. These sensitivities are accentuated right NOW WHERE OIL PRODUCING COUNTRIES ARE CONCERNED. THERE ARE ALSO PROB-LENS OF TRANS SABILITY TO IMPLEMENT CO-PRODUCTION PROJECTS RAPIDLY AND EFFICIENTY ENOUGH TO MEET THE IR EXPECTATIONS. ON BOTH COUNTS. WE NEED TO HAVE AS CLEAR AS POSSIBLE AN UNDERSTANDING OF JUST WHAT IS INVOLVED AND BE SURE WE ARE ON SOLID, DEFENSIBLE GROUND BEFORE MAKING ANY FURTHER COMMITMENTS, NOT TO DO SO WOULD BE TO TAKE UNIECE SSARY RISKS WITH US-TRAVIAN RELATIONS.

AS SOON AS THE STUDY IS CONFLETED, WE WILL PROVIDE YOU WITH GUIDANCE FOR A FULL AND FRANK DISCUSSION WITH THE SHAH ON WHAT FURTHER CO-FRODUCTION PROJECTS WE GUGHT TO UNDERTAKE, WHAT DIFFICULTIES WE ARE LIKELY TO CONFRONT IN DOING SO, AND HOW WE CAN BEST OVER COME THEM. I HOPE TO HAVE SOMETHING HORE CONCRETE WITHIN 30 DAYS.
