The upper extremities, lower extremities, and back each account for more than one-fifth of all injuries and illnesses.

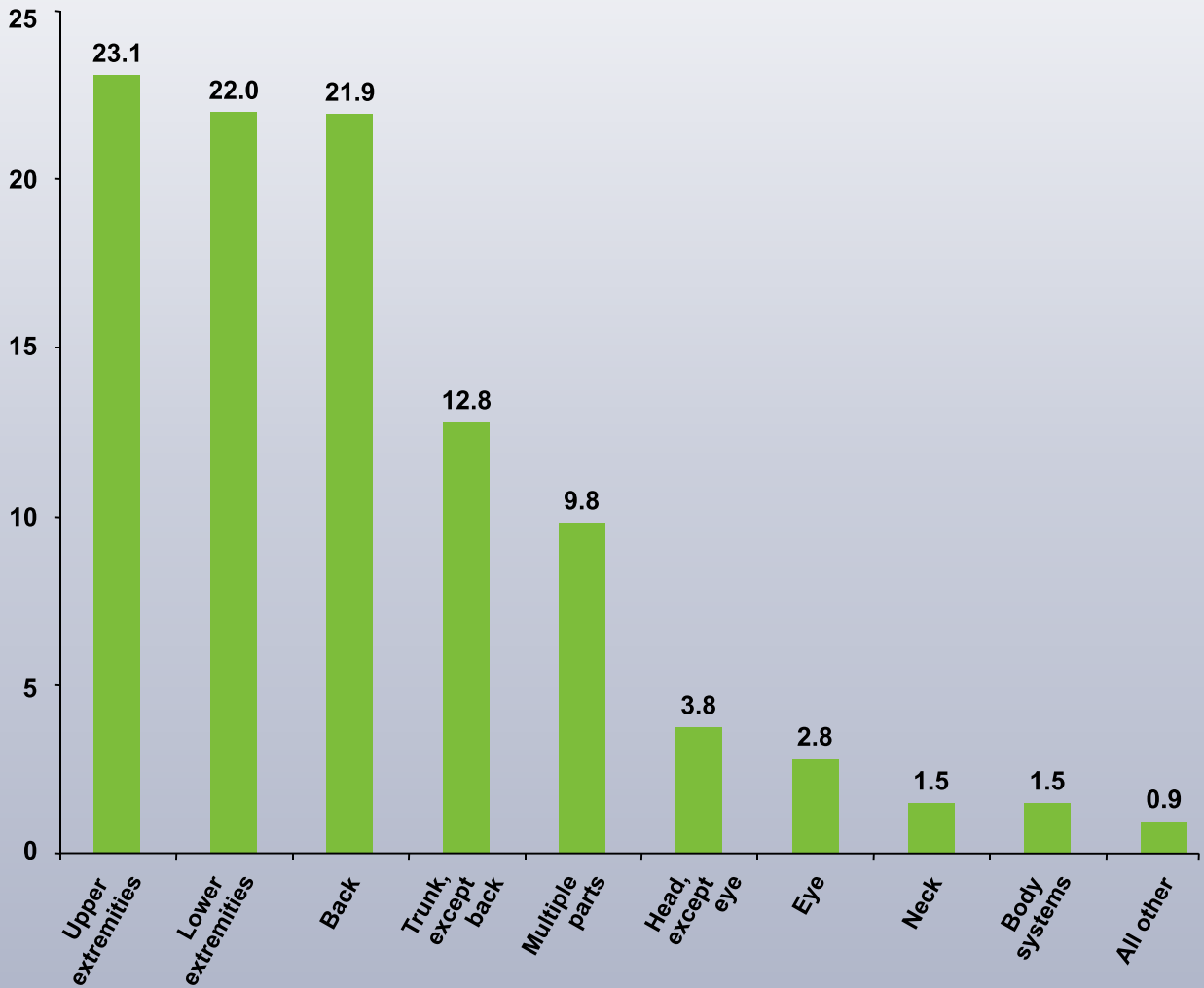
Injuries and illnesses to the upper extremities accounted for 35 percent of injuries in the accommodation and food services industry and for 32 percent of those in manufacturing.

Injuries and illnesses to the back accounted for 31 percent of injuries in health care and social assistance and for 24 percent of those in transportation and warehousing and in wholesale trade.
