To Whom It May Concern:

We at Premiere Carpets have used both P.E.T. polyester and P.T.T. polyester and have found in carpet installations that the P.T.T. products have had a superior history as far as resilience and stain resistance as well as a much softer hand in feel.

We have found that since the product has to be labeled as polyester that many consumers compare these products made with P.T.T. with the products made with P.E.T. Since P.E.T. products don't perform at the same level as the P.T.T. goods some consumers that have had P.E.T. in the past are more likely not to purchase these products based on past results. This happens even though the products perform differently. We feel that a separation is very much needed.

We do find both products to of good quality but we find superior results with the Dupont and P.T.T. products.
