Re: 16 CFR Part 303 – Textile Rule 8, Mohawk, DuPont, and PTT Canada Comment Matter No. P074201

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing this letter to petition the FTC to create a new classification for PTT carpet fiber. Mill Creek Carpet and Tile, with its-11 store locations, has been selling this fiber for the last two and one-half years and has not filed a single consumer complaint over that time period. Contrary to original polyester (PET) fiber products, this amazing fiber has separated itself from all other classifications in my opinion.

Our samples carry the fiber description as "polyester" but the former reputation of that classification should not apply to this new "wonder fiber". The stain resistance, texture retention, and overall beauty of the finished product demonstrate a dramatically upgraded finish compared to those products made with PET.

Mill Creek has not been a strong PET supporter in the past, but PTT has turned our thinking around and I believe that this fiber should be granted its own classification name.
