### **GRASS VALLEY WILDERNESS**

# 30,048 Acres Designated October 31, 1994 by the California Desert Protection Act, Public Law 103-433

This is the final legal description as required in Section 103(b) of the above mentioned Act. It describes the boundary for the Grass Valley Wilderness Area located in San Bernardino County, California and managed by the Bureau of Land Management. The boundary is more particularly described as follows:

#### **Easterly Parcel**

From the closing corner of sections 3 and 4, on the township line, Ts. 30 and 31 S., R. 44 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, being also the China Lakes Naval Air Weapons Station Mojave Range B boundary, said point being the point of beginning,

thence easterly, on said township line between sections 3 and 34, coincident with the China Lakes Naval Air Weapons Station Mojave Range B boundary, to point 1, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet westerly of centerline of a jeep trail;

thence southerly, parallel with and 30 feet westerly of centerline of said jeep trail leaving the China Lakes Naval Air Weapons Station Mojave Range B boundary,, to point 2, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet northwesterly of centerline of a jeep trail, said intersection located in the NE 1/4 of section 3;

thence southwesterly, parallel with and 30 feet northwesterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 3, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet easterly of centerline of a jeep trail, said intersection located near the east 1/16 corner of sections 7 and 18, T. 31 S., R. 44 E.;

thence northwesterly changing to northeasterly, parallel with and 30 feet northeasterly changing to southeasterly of centerline and prolongation of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 4, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet northeasterly of centerline of a jeep trail, jeep trail intersection having NAD 1927 coordinates 35° 19' 35" N. latitude, 117° 20' 55" W. longitude, as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "Blackwater Well, Calif.", 1988 (provisional);

thence northwesterly, parallel with and 30 feet northeasterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 5, the intersection of a line parallel with and 100 feet southeasterly of a jeep trail, jeep trail intersection having NAD 1927 coordinates 35° 20' 50" N. latitude, 117° 22' 22" W. longitude, as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "Blackwater Well, Calif.", 1988 (provisional);

thence northeasterly, parallel with and 100 feet southeasterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 6, the intersection of a line parallel with and 100 feet westerly of a jeep trail, said intersection being near Blackwater Well;

thence southeasterly, parallel with and 100 feet southwesterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 7, the intersection of the line between protracted sections 9 and 10, T. 30 S., R. 44 E., being also the boundary of the China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station Mojave Range B;

thence southerly, between protracted sections 9 and 10, 15 and 16, 21 and 22, 27 and 28, and 33 and 34, coincident with the China Lakes Naval Air Weapons Station Mojave Range B boundary, to point 8, the corner of sections 33 and 34 on the township line between Ts, 30 and 31 S., R. 44 E.;

thence easterly, on said township line, coincident with the China Lakes Naval Air Weapons Station Mojave Range B boundary, to the point of beginning.

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### Westerly Parcel

From the intersection of a line parallel with and 100 feet southeasterly of centerline of a jeep trail a line parallel with and 30 feet southwesterly of centerline of a jeep trail intersection having NAD 1927 coordinates 35° 20' 50" N. latitude, 117° 22' 26" W. longitude as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "Blackwater Well, Calif.", 1988 (provisional), said point being the point of beginning;

thence southeasterly, parallel with and 30 feet southwesterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 9, the intersection of a line 30 feet northwesterly of centerline of a jeep trail, jeep trail intersection having NAD 1927 coordinates 35° 19' 35" N. latitude, 117° 20' 56" W. longitude as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "Blackwater Well, Calif.", 1988 (provisional);

thence southwesterly, changing to southeasterly, parallel with and 30 feet northwesterly, changing to southwesterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 10, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet northerly of centerline of a jeep trail, said intersection located near the east 1/16 section corner of sections 7 and 18, T. 31 S., R. 44 E., Mount Diablo Meridian;

thence westerly, parallel with and 30 feet northerly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 11, the intersection of the section line between sections 16 and 17, T. 31 S., R. 43 E.;

thence northerly, between sections 16 and 17, 8 and 9, 4 and 5, to point 12, the corner of 4, 5, 32, and 33, on township line of Ts. 30 and 31 S., R. 43 E., being also the Cuddleback Lake Air Force Range boundary;

thence northerly between sections 32 and 33, 28 and 29, 20 and 21, 16 and 17, and 8 and 9, T. 30 S., R. 43 E., coincident to the Cuddleback Lake Air Force Range boundary, to point 13, the intersection of a line parallel with and 100 feet southeasterly of centerline of a jeep trail;

thence northeasterly, leaving the Cuddleback Lake Air Force Range boundary, parallel with and 100 feet southeasterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to the point of beginning.

## END OF DESCRIPTION

The above description containing approximately 30,048 acres utilizes the Bird Spring, Blackwater Well, Cuddeback Lake, Fremont Peak, and Slocum Mountain 7.5 minute quadrangle maps prepared by the U.S.G.S. The boundary calls listed herein are in part a result of scaling distances from said quadrangle maps and are not a result of survey. All courses have been depicted upon the above mentioned quadrangle maps and are made a part of this official record. Acreage is calculated from the BLM California State Office ArcInfo wilderness coverage.

I hereby certify the legal description and map herewith represent the location of the boundary of the Grass Valley Wilderness area designated by the California Desert Protection Act, Public Law 103-433 dated October 31, 1994.
