The Federal Trade Commission moves for an injunction pending appeal. The Defendants have undertaken in open court that they will take no steps to consummate the merger pending a further order of the Court of Appeals provided that the Commission files its anticipated motion for an injunction pending appeal (with a motion for expedited appeal) by Monday, October 23, 2000. The Commission represents that it is prepared to meet that schedule. With that undertaking and that representation, and because this Court is not in a position to determine whether the Court of Appeals will entertain an expedited appeal (or, if so, how long the expedited process might take), it is this 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 2000

ORDERED that the Commission's motion for an injunction pending appeal [#84] pursuant to Rule 62 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure is **denied**.
