<u>CHARLES H. LYLES AWARD CEREMONY</u> SOCIAL EVENTS

It is with great pleasure that the Gulf States Marine Fisheries Commission presents this year's *Charles H. Lyles Award* to William S. "Corky" Perret. The award will be presented on Tuesday, October 13th during a special luncheon to honor Corky and his wife Nancy. This prestigious award is presented annually to an individual, agency, or organization which has contributed to the betterment of the fisheries of the Gulf of Mexico through significant biological, industrial, legislative, enforcement or administrative activities.

It is with particular pride that the Commission is presenting this award to one of their own. Corky's career has spanned over 41 years. After graduation from the University of Louisiana he began his career at the Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Marine Lab on Grand Terre. He progressively held more and more responsible positions under numerous Governors, culminating his time in Louisiana by holding the Assistant Secretary position in charge of both fresh and marine fisheries for the state in 1995.

He retired from the State of Louisiana after more than 35 years of service, but he wasn't ready to stay home. He went to work with the State of Mississippi as Chief of Marine Resources. He held that position until recently when he advanced to the Assistant Director of Mississippi Marine Resources, the position he held until his retirement in June 2009.

His work and influence on individuals he has come in contact with for the numerous boards, commissions and councils has been profound. While Corky will never be replaced, he will be missed for his wit and as an unflagging champion for marine resources, their users and the habitat that support them.
