AGREED SCHEDULING ORDER


Based upon the agreement between the Examiner and Respondent, as reflected by the signatures of their respective counsel below, it is ORDERED:

1. That this case is set for hearing before the Special Master on August 17, 2009, at the following location: The 37th District Court, 100 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas 78205.
2. That Examiner shall designate any retained experts in compliance with TRCP 194.2(f) on or before June 4, 2009.
3. That Respondent shall designate any retained experts in compliance with TRCP 194.2(f) on or before July 1, 2009.
4. That Examiner shall designate any retained rebuttal witnesses on or before July 15, 2009.
5. That all discovery shall be completed by July 17, 2009.
6. That the parties shall amend their pleadings on or before June 15, 2009.¹
7. That the parties shall (i) designate all page and line references to all deposition testimony to be offered at the hearing by August 3, 2009, (ii) designate any objections or cross-designations to the other party's designations by August 10, 2009; and (iii) designate any objections to cross-designations by August 14, 2009.
8. That the parties shall exchange witness and exhibit lists by August 3, 2009.


¹ The Respondent believes that the law does not permit the Commission to amend the "Notice of Formal Proceedings" to add additional charges or facts. By agreeing to this scheduling order the Respondent does not waive her position in that regard but agrees that if amendments are permitted the parties shall amend their pleadings on or before June 15, 2009.


- 9. That all parties shall make objections to exhibits by August 10, 2009.
- 10. That this agreed order may be modified (i) by agreement of the parties (except as to item 1 above) or (ii) by the Special Master for good cause shown.
