- 5. That all discovery shall be completed by July 17, 2009.
- That the parties shall amend their pleadings on or before June 15, 2009.
- 7. That the parties shall (i) designate all page and line references to all deposition testimony to be offered at the hearing by August 3, 2009, (ii) designate any objections or cross-designations to the other party's designations by August 10, 2009; and (iii) designate any objections to cross-designations by August 14, 2009.
- 8. That the parties shall exchange witness and exhibit lists by August 3, 2009.
