

# **Electronic and Information Resources Accessibility Policy**

## **Texas Department of Savings and Mortgage Lending**

The Texas Department of Savings and Mortgage Lending (TDSML) is committed to making all aspects of the Department's electronic and information resources accessible to all users.

### **Accessibility Coordinator**

The Department has designated a staff member to serve as the Accessibility Coordinator. The Accessibility Coordinator, along with a committee consisting of relevant staff, will monitor the Department's compliance with this policy and assist in implementation of revisions. The Department's Accessibility Coordinator may grant written requests for exceptions to this policy as appropriate. The committee will meet annually to review the continued appropriateness of the policy, with called meetings in the interim, as needed.

### **Web Accessibility Policy**

It is the policy of TDSML that all official TDSML information published on our website shall be accessible to all users. The Department has adopted the access standards of Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and therefore all web pages containing official Department information that are built, updated or revised after the effective date of this policy must comply with Section 508 requirements.
