#### **Busy November Agenda for Board**

When the Board holds its next board meeting on November 21<sup>st</sup> at the Renaissance Hotel in Austin there will be a full and interesting agenda. The Board will have a proposed rule to discuss, and perhaps adopt.

At the last meeting over July 31-August 1<sup>st</sup>, the Board discussed the OT Practice Act and changes important to the Board. Ordinarily the Texas Board of Occupational Therapy Examiners would have gone through the Sunset process, but the Sunset review of the agency has been postponed twice. This may be seen positively for the agency in that the agency is running successfully. However the agency has not been able to make any needed changes. Until the OT Practice Act goes through Sunset review or legislation is passed to amend the Act, language remains that needs updating.

The Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS) has posted Provider Letter 08-17 which notified nursing homes and assisted living facilities that if they take in patients who are not residents of the facility, they are providing out-patient services and thus must register the facility with this board for OT and/or PT services. Respite care which includes these patients in their bed count is exempt. For more information contact the board.

# Four Rules Adopted One Amendment Proposed

The Texas Board of Occupational Therapy Examiners held their quarterly board meeting on July 31-Aug 1, 2008, at which time they adopted the three rules which had been proposed at their April board meeting. Please get the actual wording on the Act/Rules page of the website.

#### 1. **§375.1**, Fees

The board proposed inserting new language in this rule which directs the reader to the Executive Council's OT fee schedule for the actual amounts. The wording which limited payments to checks and money orders was deleted, as Texas accepts online payment with credit cards.

# 2. §373.3, Supervision of a Licensed Occupational Therapy Assistant The board proposed inserting wording in (b) which recognizes when the COTA/LOTA works as a LOTA/COTA or in another role as pertains to the COTA Supervision Log.

# 3. **§376.3, Requirements for Registration Application (Facilities)**The board proposed inserting wording in (a)(5) which requires the notarized signature of the LOT/OTR on the Therapist-in-Charge form.

#### 4. §376.4, Requirements for Registered Facilities

The board proposed adding wording to (d) which clarifies that the facility must obtain a new registration and/or renewal certificate if the facility's name and/or physical address change.

Several definitions are proposed to be deleted as unnecessary. Two were changed to reflect the same definition as those in the OT Practice Act for OT and OTA. Refer to the Act/Rules page for the proposed wording.
