

# Update on Priority Watershed

- Mustang Creek was selected by the WCSC in December 2007 for WPP development
- > TSSWCB, LNRA, and Extension met in early January to discuss WPP
- > This discussion led to delaying any stakeholder process due to lack of data in the watershed and potential for significant contribution from WWTFs
- February 2008, LNRA submitted a proposal to the TSSWCB for a SWQM project for the Mustang Creek Watershed funded by FY2008 319 grant money in order to better understand nutrient loadings and sources, and support sufficient stakeholder commitment




## Update on WCSC priority Watersheds

### Plum Creek Watershed Partnership


