TANF Basic is the assistance program for qualified child-only or single parent families once a year.

TANF State Program assists qualified two-parent families & is funded with State General Revenue dollars.

One-Time TANF is a cash-only alternative to Basic or State Program and is available to qualifying families once a year.

Grandparent TANF is a cash-only supplement to Basic or State program benefits and is available to grandparents responsible for raising their qualifying child(ren).
