5. 2007-2010 Rule Review Plan for State Board for Educator Certification Rules

This item outlines the rule review plan for State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) rules during the period of 2007 through 2010. Texas Government Code, §2001.039, requires a rule review of existing state agency rules, including SBEC rules. The rule review requirement is designed to ensure that the reason for initially adopting a rule continues to exist.

6. Discussion of Proposed Reduction of Certificates Issued:

At the present time, there are 144 different types of certificates issued. At the same time, there are 83 different types of examination tests for securing a teaching certificate. One of the stated SBEC goals is to reduce the number of certificates available for issuance.

In reviewing the database we found 61 certificates that are no longer being issued as **initial** certificates; however, since September 1, 1999, they are being issued as standard five-year renewable certificates. We will need to continue keeping these certificates active for future renewals.

In addition, we have found an additional 21 certificates that are considered obsolete since they were issued as specialization areas which are no longer available. Furthermore, we found 2 certificates that do not have tests available for the issuance of a certificate; they can be deleted.

The rules under review provide requirements for admission to an educator preparation program and the Teach for Texas Pilot Program.

This item also provides the SBEC an opportunity to approve the proposed revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 227, <u>Provisions for Educator Preparation Students</u>, as part of the statutorily-required review of existing rules. The proposed revisions would update the rules to reflect current law, add minimum standards for all educator preparation programs, while still allowing flexibility, and ensure consistency among educator preparation programs in the state. This item also proposes additional changes to incorporate recommendations following the March 7, 2008, SBEC meeting.

9. Adoption of the Review of and Proposed Revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 228, Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs, and Proposed Repeal of 19 TAC Chapter 230, Professional Educator Preparation and Certification, Subchapter G, Certification Requirement for Classroom Teachers, §230.191, Preparation Required in All Programs

Texas Government Code, §2001.039, establishes a four-year rule review cycle for all state agency rules, including State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) rules. This item presents for SBEC consideration the adoption of the review of 19 TAC Chapter 228, <u>Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs</u>. The rules under review provide requirements relating to educator preparation programs.

This item also provides the SBEC an opportunity to approve the proposed revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 228, Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs, as part of the statutorily-required review of existing rules. The proposed revisions would update the rules to reflect current law, add minimum standards for all educator preparation programs, while still allowing flexibility, and ensure consistency among the educator preparation programs in the state. This item also proposes additional changes to incorporate recommendations following the March 7, 2008, SBEC meeting. In addition, this item provides the SBEC an opportunity to approve the proposed repeal of 19 TAC §230.191, Preparation Required in All Programs. Program preparation requirements in this rule have been incorporated into the proposed revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 228 or have an expiration date in rule of September 1, 2007.

10. Adoption of Proposed Amendments to 19 TAC Chapter 232, <u>General Certification Provisions</u>, Subchapter A, <u>Types and Classes of Certificates Issued</u>, §232.4, <u>Probationary Certificates</u>, and §232.5, <u>Temporary Teacher Certificates</u>

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an opportunity to adopt, subject to State Board of Education (SBOE) review, the proposed amendments to 19 TAC Chapter 232, General Certification Provisions, Subchapter A, Types and Classes of Certificates Issued, §232.4, Probationary Certificates, and §232.5, Temporary Teacher Certificates. The proposed amendments would clarify the requirements for probationary certificates and temporary teacher certificates. The proposed amendments would also address special education assignment at the public middle school or high school level (Grades 7-12) and training requirements for temporary teacher certificate holders. No additional changes are recommended since published as proposed.

11. Approval of 2006-2007 Accountability System for Educator Preparation (ASEP) Accreditation Ratings

The Board will discuss and approve the 2006-2007 Accountability System for Educator Preparation (ASEP) accreditation ratings for the Educator Preparation Programs authorized by Texas Education Code §21.045.

12. Proposed Revisions to Board Operating Policies and Procedures (BOPP)

This item provides the Board the opportunity to approve the requested changes from the March 2008 SBEC meeting to the Board Operating Policies and Procedures (BOPP).

13. Approval of the Comparability Study of the TExES Math 4-8 and Math 8-12 Exams with Louisiana Certification Exams

In order to continue the implementation of HB 1721, the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) will accept the committee recommendation for the test-level comparability study results for the TExES #135 Mathematics 8-12 certification examination to the Praxis #0061 Mathematics Content Knowledge test and the TExES #115 Mathematics 4-8 certification examination to the Praxis #0069 Middle School Mathematics test. The objective of the test-level comparability study is to determine the appropriateness of offering certified educators from Louisiana who have tested and successfully passed Louisiana certification tests the opportunity of possibly being exempted from taking TExES examinations.
