# **DISCUSSION AND ACTION**

5. Adoption of Proposed Revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 227, <u>Provisions for Educator Preparation Students</u>

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an opportunity to adopt, subject to State Board of Education (SBOE) review, the proposed revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 227, <u>Provisions for Educator Preparation Students</u>. The proposed revisions would update the rules to reflect current law, add minimum standards for all educator preparation programs, while still allowing flexibility, and ensure consistency among educator preparation programs in the state. Additional changes are recommended to 19 TAC §227.10, <u>Admission Criteria</u>, since published as proposed.

6. Adoption of Proposed Revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 228, Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs, and Proposed Repeal of 19 TAC Chapter 230, Professional Educator Preparation and Certification, Subchapter G, Certification Requirement for Classroom Teachers, §230.191, Preparation Required in All Programs

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an opportunity to adopt, subject to State Board of Education (SBOE) review, the proposed revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 228, <u>Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs</u>. The proposed revisions would update the rules to reflect current law, add minimum standards for all educator preparation programs, while still allowing flexibility, and ensure consistency among the educator preparation programs in the state. Additional changes are recommended to 19 TAC §228.40, <u>Assessment and Evaluation of Candidates for Certification and Program Improvement</u>, since published as proposed.

In addition, this item provides the SBEC an opportunity to adopt, subject to SBOE review, the proposed repeal of 19 TAC §230.191, <u>Preparation Required in All Programs</u>. Program preparation requirements in this rule have been incorporated into the proposed revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 228 or have an expiration date in rule of September 1, 2007. No additional changes are recommended since published as proposed.

# 7. Consideration and Opportunity to Approve the Revision of the 2006-2007 Accountability System for Educator Preparation (ASEP) Accreditation Ratings

The Board will discuss and have the opportunity to approve the 2006-2007 Accountability System for Educator Preparation (ASEP) accreditation ratings for the educator preparation programs authorized by Texas Education Code §21.045.

# 8. Proposed Plan for the Use of the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) Examination for Bilingual Language Proficiency

The State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) will discuss and have the opportunity to approve the use of Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Russian and Vietnamese American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Language (ACTFL) exams to meet the language proficiency requirement for the bilingual certification where no state examinations currently exist.

# 9. Consolidation of Bilingual Supplemental Certification Examinations

The item presents the opportunity to discuss and approve a proposal to offer one Bilingual Supplemental examination that will attach to the grade level content certificate and follow the format of the other supplemental examinations offered.

## 10. Consideration and Opportunity for Approval of Educator Preparation Program Expansion Plan

The Board will have the opportunity to discuss and approve a plan for consideration and approval of Educator Preparation Programs' requests for expansion, and will authorize staff to draft policies, procedures, and proposed rules as needed to carry out the plan.

# 11. Consideration and Opportunity to Approve the Recommendation that A Visually Impaired Teacher Take Visually Impaired Training in Addition to Examination as a Requirement for Visually Impaired Certification

The agenda item is being presented to the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) to provide it with the opportunity for discussion and approval of a recommendation that addresses a concern that the needs of visually impaired (VI) students across the state are not being addressed. The main concern is that certified educators are allowed, pursuant to Texas Administrative Code § 230.437, to take the Visually Impaired certification examination without additional VI training.

# 12. Consideration and Opportunity for Approval of Education Service Center Region IV Proposal for Mandarin Chinese Language Teacher Alternative Certification Pilot Program

# 17. Review of 19 TAC Chapter 230, Professional Educator Preparation and Certification

Texas Government Code, §2001.039, establishes a four-year rule review cycle for all state agency rules, including State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) rules. This item presents the review of 19 TAC Chapter 230, <u>Professional Educator Preparation and Certification</u>. The rules being reviewed provide requirements relating to assessment of educators; centers for professional development of teachers; certification requirements for classroom teachers; certification requirements for educators other than classroom teachers and educational aides; certification of educators in general; certificate issuance procedures; Texas educator certificates based on certification and college credentials from other states or territories of the United States; requirements for standard certificates and specialized assignments or

programs; permits; educational aide certificate; assignment of public school personnel; continuing education; and definitions.

# 18. Discussion of Goals and Priorities of the 19 TAC Chapter 229, <u>Accountability System for Educator</u> Preparation

This item presents for discussion upcoming revisions and/or redevelopment of 19 TAC Chapter 229, <u>Accountability System for Educator Preparation</u>, as part of the statutorily-required review of existing rules. The proposed revisions would update the rules to reflect current law and would add specificity to the requirements relating to the accreditation of entities that prepare individuals for educator certification.

19. Discussion of Proposed Amendments to 19 TAC Chapter 249, <u>Disciplinary Proceedings, Sanctions and Contested Cases</u>, Subchapter B, <u>Enforcement Actions and Guidelines</u>, §249.16, <u>Eligibility of Persons with Criminal Convictions for a Certificate under Articles 6252-13c and 6252-13d, Revised Civil Statues</u>, including technical edits to 19 TAC §249.3, <u>Definitions</u>, §249.15, <u>Disciplinary Action by State Board for Educator Certification</u>, and §232.830, Requirements for Certificate Renewal

This item presents proposed amendment to 19 TAC Chapter 249, <u>Disciplinary Proceedings, Sanctions, and Contested Cases</u>, Subchapter B, <u>Enforcement Actions and Guidelines</u>, §249.16, <u>Eligibility of Persons with Criminal Convictions for a Certificate under Articles 6252-13c and 6252-13d, Revised Civil Statutes</u>, for discussion. The proposed amendment would update the current rule to reflect current law and define crimes other than those listed in the Texas Education Code (TEC), §21.060, as being related to the duties and responsibilities of the education profession. In addition, this item presents proposed amendments to 19 TAC §249.3, <u>Definitions</u>, §249.15, <u>Disciplinary Action by State Board for Educator Certification</u>, and §232.830, <u>Requirements for Certificate Renewal</u>, for discussion. The proposed amendments would be necessary to update the current rules to reflect the proposed section title for 19 TAC §249.16.
