This item presents the State Board for Education Certification (SBEC) the opportunity to approve the new Educator Standards Advisory Committee members.

### 9. Consideration of and Opportunity to Approve the Passing Standard on the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) Examinations for Bilingual Language Proficiency

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) the opportunity to review a standard-setting report and approve a passing standard for oral and written proficiency on the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and Written Proficiency Test (WPT) in Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, and Vietnamese.

# 10. Consideration of and Opportunity to Approve the Comparability Study of the TExES Chemistry (140) and the Praxis Chemistry (0245) Certification Examinations

In order to continue the implementation of House Bill 1721, the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) will have the opportunity to accept the committee recommendation for the test-level comparability study results for the TExES #140 Chemistry 8-12 certification examination to the Praxis #0245 Chemistry Content Knowledge test. The objective of the test-level comparability study is to determine the appropriateness of offering certified educators from other states who have tested and successfully passed other certification tests, the opportunity of possibly being exempted from taking TExES examinations.

# 11. Consideration of and Opportunity to Approve the 2007-2008 Accountability System for Educator Preparation (ASEP) Accreditation Ratings

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) the opportunity to discuss and approve the 2007-2008 accountability system for educator preparation accreditation ratings. The attached list of ratings reflects the accreditation ratings for educator preparation programs for 2007-2008. There are no programs "Accredited-Preliminary" or "Accredited-Under Review". There are 145 programs rated as "Accredited". Six programs, however, will submit Action Plans due to low pass rates and small numbers in a demographic group in accordance with §229.3.

### 12. Adoption of Proposed Amendment to 19 TAC Chapter 232, General Certification Provisions, Subchapter A, Types and Classes of Certificates Issued, §232.4, Probationary Certificates

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an opportunity to adopt, subject to State Board of Education (SBOE) review, the proposed amendment to 19 TAC Chapter 232, <u>General Certification Provisions</u>, Subchapter A, <u>Types and Classes of Certificates Issued</u>, §232.4, <u>Probationary Certificates</u>. The proposed amendment would remove language that allows the SBEC to grant a waiver of the baccalaureate degree requirement for a probationary certificate that requires such a degree. The proposed amendment would also grant an additional year's extension of a probationary certificate to an educator whose contract is terminated, or who resigns in lieu of termination, before the end of a school year due to a reduction in force by a school district. No additional changes are recommended since published as proposed.

### 13. <u>Adoption of Proposed Amendments to 19 TAC Chapter 233, Categories of</u> <u>Classroom Teaching Certificates, §233.1, General Authority, and §233.15,</u> <u>Languages Other Than English</u>

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an opportunity to adopt, subject to State Board of Education (SBOE) review, the proposed amendments to 19 TAC Chapter 233, <u>Categories of Classroom Teaching Certificates</u>, §233.1, <u>General Authority</u>, and §233.15, <u>Languages Other Than English</u>. The proposed amendments would require an oral proficiency examination for languages other than English (LOTE) certificates. The proposed amendments would also expand the certificates issued for LOTE by adding four new certificates for French, German, and Spanish to be issued no earlier than November 1, 2009, and for Latin to be issued no earlier than January 1, 2010. No additional changes are recommended since published as proposed.

# 14. Adoption of Proposed Revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 241, Principal Certificate

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an opportunity to adopt, subject to State Board of Education (SBOE) review, the proposed revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 241, <u>Principal Certificate</u>. The proposed revisions would update the rules to reflect current law and add specificity to educator preparation and certification requirements relating to the principal certificate. No additional changes are recommended since published as proposed.

# 15. Adoption of Proposed Revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 242, Superintendent Certificate

This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an opportunity to adopt, subject to State Board of Education (SBOE) review, the proposed revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 242, <u>Superintendent Certificate</u>. The proposed revisions would update the rules to reflect current law and add specificity to educator preparation and certification requirements relating to the superintendent certificate. No additional changes are recommended since published as proposed.

16. <u>Adoption of Proposed Amendment to 19 TAC Chapter 249, Disciplinary</u> <u>Proceedings, Sanctions, and Contested Cases, Subchapter B, Enforcement</u> <u>Actions and Guidelines, §249.14, Complaint, Required Reporting, and</u> <u>Investigation; Investigative Notice; Filing of Petition</u> This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an opportunity to adopt, subject to State Board of Education (SBOE) review, the proposed amendment to 19 TAC Chapter 249, <u>Disciplinary Proceedings, Sanctions, and Contested Cases</u>, Subchapter B, <u>Enforcement Actions and Guidelines</u>, §249.14, <u>Complaint, Required</u> <u>Reporting, and Investigation; Investigative Notice; Filing of Petition</u>. The proposed amendment to report alleged misconduct of an educator who resigns from a school district, the minimum requirements of a superintendent's report, and the requirements for a school district to request that the Texas Education Agency (TEA) pursue sanctions against an educator who has abandoned his or her contract in violation of the Texas Education Code (TEC),  $\S$ 21.105(c)(2), 21.160(c)(2), or 21.210(c)(2). No additional changes are recommended since published as proposed.

# 17. Proposed Revisions to Board Operating Policies and Procedures (BOPP)

The Board will have the opportunity to amend the Board Operating Policies and Procedures (BOPP). After discussion at the May 14, 2009 AD Hoc Committee meeting, the committee recommended that the testimony on a disciplinary case be limited to 5 minutes (see page 10 IV.A.b.4).
