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RECENT CHANGE TO SPRINKLER RULES CONCERNING EXTENSION OF RME-I LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

March 3, 2008

The Texas Department of Insurance sent an adoption order to the Texas Register pertaining to a change of the Fire Sprinkler Rules section §34.716(c). This order is expected to be printed in the March 14, 2008, issue of the Texas Register. Currently the inspection, test and maintenance service of a fire protection sprinkler system, except for a one- and two-family dwelling or an underground fire main, must be performed by an individual holding a current RME-General Inspector or RME-General license beginning January 1, 2008. This change extends the date from January 1, 2008 to January 1, 2009. This adoption order will take effect on March 23, 2008.
