# ADDENDUM F. LOCAL OPTION ELECTIONS

There were three local option elections during the fiscal year ending August 31, 1994. All three elections were called to legalize the sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only. As a result of these elections one jurisdiction remained "wet," one became "wet," and one remained "dry."

The voting for the fiscal year:

### DENTON COUNTY

A local option election was held on September 29, 1993, in the City of Aubrey, Denton County, for the issue of "The legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only." The issue failed by a vote of 103 FOR and 127 AGAINST. The City of Aubrey, Denton County, was "dry" before the election and remains "dry."

#### **FANNIN COUNTY**

A local option election was held on June 21, 1994, in the City of LaDonna, Fannin County, for the issue of "The legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only." The issue passed by a vote of 36 FOR and 21 AGAINST. The City of LaDonna, Fannin County, was "wet" before the election and remains "wet" for the legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only.

#### TITUS COUNTY

A local option election was held on April 23, 1994, in the City of Winfield, Titus County, for the issue of "The legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only." The issue passed by a vote of 139 FOR and 72 AGAINST. The City of Winfield, Titus County, was "dry" before the election and became "wet" for the legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only.
