# Austin Biotech Workforce Education Consortium Key Issues and Challenges

#### Process issues

 The grant period is 24 months but the funding was split into two 1-year contracts which requires more administrative work

#### Project issues

- In hindsight we would have benefited from a more targeted outreach approach
- Should have requested additional funding for marketing to promote awareness of the industry
