**ORDER DETERMINING PLAINTIFF TO BE A  
VEXATIOUS LITIGANT UNDER CHAPTER 11 OF THE TEXAS  
CIVIL PRACTICES AND REMEDIES CODE AND SETTING SECURITY**


On this day, the Court heard Defendant Washington Mutual Bank's Motion for an Order Determining Plaintiff to be a Vexatious Litigant Under Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code and Requesting Security. After consideration of the Motion, the exhibits and arguments of counsel, the Court finds that same should be GRANTED, in all things. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Plaintiff, Dallas Wayne Scott, is hereby determined by the Court to be a vexatious litigant, as that term is used in Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code. It is further

ORDERED that on or before June 28, 2002, Plaintiff shall furnish security in the form of an executed bond in the amount of \$ 5000<sup>00</sup>, with two or more good and sufficient sureties to be approved by the Clerk, or a cash deposit in such amount in lieu thereof, for the benefit of Defendant Washington Mutual Bank ("Washington Mutual"), to assure payment to Washington Mutual of its reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation. It is further

ORDERED that, based upon the findings herein that Dallas Wayne Scott is a vexatious litigant, Dallas Wayne Scott is hereby prohibited from filing, in propria persona, any new litigation in a court in the State of Texas without first obtaining approval from the local administrative judge of the court in which Dallas Wayne Scott seeks to file the litigation,

pursuant to Section 11.102 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code. *Should Plaintiff post bond and prevail in this action, this prohibition shall be terminated*
