ORDER

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this day came to be considered Defendant TDCJ's Motion to Declare Plaintiff as a Vexatious Litigant. After considering the pleadings of the parties filed herein and the argument of counsel, the Court is of the opinion that the motion is meritorious and that the following order should issue:

It is hereby ORDERED that said Motion is GRANTED. Plaintiff Michael Moore a/k/a Mikal Ali Muhammad, TDCJ #487939 is hereby DETERMINED TO BE A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT.

THEREFORE, Moore is ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$ 1,000.00. The amount must be furnished to the court by May 1, 2002. Should Plaintiff fail to furnish such security within the time set by this Order, the above referenced and numbered cause is DISMISSED. Should the case be dismissed upon its merits, Plaintiff shall pay Defendant's reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation, including costs and attorney's fees.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the court shall refuse the filing of any litigation presented by Michael Moore a/k/a Mikal Ali Muhammad, TDCJ #487939 unless he obtains an order from the local administrative judge permitting the filing.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that Michael Moore a/k/a Mikal Ali Muhammad, TDCJ #487939 is prohibited from filing, *in propria persona*, any new litigation in a court in this state.
