 - department chair or director of an interpreter training program, or
 - interpreter who holds DHHS court interpreter certification;
- 4. Completed DARS3904, Mentor Training Plan available at www.dars.state.tx.us/dhhs or from the DHHS office; and
- 5. Check or money order for the applicable fee payable to **DARS DHHS**.
