- 8 (b) The commission by rule shall adopt a model <u>alcohol and</u>
- 9 drug testing policy for use by a towing company. The model alcohol
- 10 and drug testing policy must be designed to ensure the safety of the
- 11 public through appropriate <u>alcohol and</u> drug testing and to protect
- 12 the rights of employees. The model <u>alcohol and</u> drug testing policy

- 16 (2) authorize random, unannounced <u>alcohol and</u> drug
- 17 testing for towing operators.
- 18 SECTION 11. Subsection (a), Section 2308.251, Occupations
- 19 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 20 (a) The owner or operator of a vehicle may not leave
- 21 unattended on a parking facility a vehicle that:
- 22 (1) is in or obstructs a vehicular traffic aisle,
- 23 entry, or exit of the parking facility;
- 24 (2) prevents a vehicle from exiting a parking space in
- 25 the facility;
- 26 (3) is in or obstructs a fire lane marked according to
- 27 Subsection (c); [or]

- 1 (4) does not display the special license plates issued
- 2 under Section 504.201, Transportation Code, or the disabled parking
- 3 placard issued under Chapter 681, Transportation Code, for a
- 4 vehicle transporting a disabled person and is in a parking space
- 5 that is designated for the exclusive use of a vehicle transporting a
- 6 disabled person; or
- 7 (5) is leaking a fluid that presents a hazard or threat
- 8 to persons or property.
- 9 SECTION 12. Subchapter F, Chapter 2308, Occupations Code,
- 10 is amended by adding Section 2308.257 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 2308.257. REMOVAL OF CERTAIN UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES IN
- 12 RURAL AREAS. (a) This section applies only to an abandoned
- 13 vehicle that has damaged a fence on private property in a rural
- 14 area.
- 15 (b) A law enforcement agency directing a towing company or
- 16 tow operator to remove an abandoned vehicle that is located on
- 17 private property shall provide the towing company or tow operator
- 18 with the name and telephone number of the property owner or the
- 19 owner's agent if the owner or agent has provided the information to
- 20 the law enforcement agency.
- 21 (c) A towing company or tow operator provided with
- 22 <u>information under Subsection (b) shall contact the property owner</u>
- 23 or the owner's agent before entering private property to tow a
- 24 <u>vehicle described by Subsection (a).</u>
- 25 SECTION 13. Sections 2308.207 and 2308.256, Occupations
- 26 Code, are repealed.
- 27 SECTION 14. (a) The changes in law made by this Act to

- 1 Sections 2308.153, 2308.154, and 2308.155, Occupations Code, apply
- 2 only to a license application filed on or after the effective date
- 3 of this Act. A license application filed before the effective date
- 4 of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the license
- 5 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 6 that purpose.
- 7 (b) Not later than April 1, 2010, the Texas Commission of
- 8 Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the model alcohol and drug
- 9 testing policy required by Section 2308.158, Occupations Code, as
- 10 amended by this Act.
