



CHILD SUPPORT EVADER BRAD HENDERSON

ATTORNEY GENERAL GREG ABBOTT needs your help to find Child Support Evader Brad Henderson, one of the Most Wanted Child Support Evaders in Texas. He was named a Child Support Evader in December 2005. He owes over \$99,000 for the care of three daughters, who live with their mother in Beeville.



In 1998, when Henderson and the girls' mother divorced, Henderson was ordered to make monthly payments of \$800 for his three children's care. He did not abide by the order. An arrest warrant was issued after Henderson, although properly notified, failed to appear at a January 2003 enforcement hearing to address his noncompliance. He is wanted on a \$10,000 cash bond that, if paid, will go to the mother and his children.

Henderson, who has not made a child support payment in more than five years, has turned his back on his daughters by refusing to provide financial assistance they need to succeed in life. Due to missed payments and interest that accrues on unpaid child support, he now owes more than \$ 99,000.

Investigators from the Attorney General's Office have searched the state for Henderson. He is believed to be living in the Beeville area. Contact the Attorney General's Office at 1-866-EVADERS (382-3377) to report information that may lead to the arrest of Brad Henderson.

POINTS TO REMEMBER



MOST WANTED EVADERS

CRITERIA: For a parent to be named as a Most Wanted Child Support Evader:

- Court-ordered delinquent support must be in excess of \$5,000
- Arrest warrant must have been issued for non-support
- Location of non-custodial parent is unknown
- Parent has not made any payments in the last six months
- Non-custodial parent must not be involved in bankruptcy proceedings
- Non-custodial parent must not be receiving welfare benefits

In order to make child support information public, the custodial parent must sign a confidentiality waiver.
