n 1997, the courtstuff.com site began offering a "first-in-the-nation" innovation called vNotices! With these "Virtual Notices", users can register their email address and receive email notification of opinions issued and case docket activity. vNotices! come in several varieties:

pinion vNotices! When users register, they can optionally select the type of Opinion vNotices! (e.g. All, Only Published, Only Civil, Only Criminal). Opinion vNotices! (with hypertext links to the full-text) are emailed to users daily. Register to receive vNotices! URL: http://courtstuff.com/5th/register.html

ase vNotices! Registered users can "subscribe" the cases which they wish to monitor. (Note! Users registering with a barcard# are "autosubscribed") When the website is updated, if activity occurs for a "subscribed" case, a summary of case activity is emailed. Calendar vNotices! are emailed on the case's calendar "Due" date, Tickler vNotices! for cases are emailed 1 week before the calendar "Due" date.
